

## Partner with us as we go green(er)

In the summer of 2022, **Big Sky Solar and Wind** installed 32 solar panels on the southern roof of the Carousel building which have been generating energy to power our ponies throughout the fall months.

As an educational piece to accompany the solar project and provide sustainability in other ways, we will also install a "Recycling Dragon." The dragon's limestone head, carved by **John Thompson**, will be emerging from a lair located between the Carousel and

Dragon Hollow Playarea. Holes in the wall of the lair will allow park guests to deposit garbage and recycling in appropriate receptacles. The dragon will reward depositors with flashing lights and a thank you roar. The dragon's home will be built by **Dirik Dubay from Western Montana Patio**, **Mike Sudik of Big Sky Solar and Wind, Cale Fylling Concrete, John Thompson and Adrian Hoye**
